

Frequently Asked Questions



Will stores provide both formula products during this transition?

IDHS encourages Illinois WIC vendors to stock both Mead Johnson and Abbott products through April 30, 2026, allowing WIC families with Mead Johnson-issued formula to still find Mead Johnson products at all WIC-approved vendors. However, some WIC-approved vendors, especially smaller vendors that normally do not carry both brands, may choose to switch over on or before Feb. 1, 2026. Please refer your patients to their WIC provider if they are unable to find WIC-approved formula.

Do other medical providers know about the formula change?

IDHS shared the crosswalk, timeline, and other relevant information with the medical community in October 2025, and IDHS will provide guidance to hospitals or doctors that reach out with any questions. Please refer to the Abbott website at abbottnutrition.com for product descriptions.

What if participants use a medically prescribed/specialty formula?

Illinois WIC provides a limited number of medically prescribed specialty formulas. These items have been modified for special medical conditions and as such are not part of the infant formula contract. The process to receive these will not change. Mead Johnson products which are currently considered as contract but do not meet the "specialty" status include Enfamil AR and Enfamil Reguline. Starting Feb. 1, 2026, families can request that these formulas be covered through Illinois Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) via a durable medical equipment (DME) provider when medically necessary with a prescription from their medical provider.

Do these products offer the same nutritional value?

Enfamil and Similac formulas are nutritionally comparable, and both meet federal standards for infant formula.

What if a child has a dietary restriction?

Certain formulas meet dietary and religious restrictions such as Kosher and Halal formulas. Additionally, all contract products are vegetarian.
