

ODU TREATMENT FELLOWSHIP **ECHO[®] PROGRAM** **FOR PRACTICING PROVIDERS**



This 7-month fellowship trains **primary care providers** in the assessment and treatment of **opioid use disorder (OUD)**. The goal is to expand access to evidence-based OUD treatment, especially in underserved areas.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS MUST COMMIT TO TWO REQUIREMENTS:

ATTEND THE ONLINE WEEKEND IMMERSION COURSE

Engage in didactics, case discussions, and practical tools via Zoom with a multidisciplinary faculty team. Participants must have video, a stable internet connection, and a quiet environment, and commit to keeping their video on for full participation.

ATTEND WEEKLY ECHO[®] WEBINARS

Attend weekly webinars. Each fellow will present and receive feedback on a case and participate in additional didactics on topics not covered during weekend immersion.

ELIGIBLE SENIOR FELLOWS MUST COMMIT TO:




1. Help facilitate the online preparation course (Date TBA)
2. Champion a group of 6-7 fellows during the training weekend and throughout the fellowship.
3. Serve on an advisory team led by the Co-Leads (first Friday monthly meetings).
4. Complete monthly check-ins with the championed group, as well as respond to the group members' questions on an online discussion board.
5. Act as a subject matter expert during approximately eight case webinars (Tuesdays, noon-1pm).
6. Provide the opportunity for fellows to shadow if they are interested.

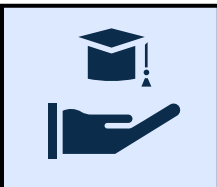

ELIGIBLE CO-LEADS MUST COMMIT TO:

Help facilitate the Cohort 11 OUD preparation course	5 hours* (occurs once)
Prepare for and attend weekly ECHO® webinars sessions on Tuesdays, 12pm-1pm	1 hour/month
Review all weekly ECHO® cases submitted by fellows, offer feedback, and approve finalized versions (after Sr. Fellow review)	2 hours/month
Offer support to the SME before the SME presents didactics	1 hour/month
Attend the advisory team meeting(s)	1 hour/month
Review and deliver a 35- 40 minute didactic during the weekly webinars	60 minutes total* (occurs once)
Review Slack comments and answer questions or delegate to other subject matter experts if needed	30 minutes/month
Post to Slack TWICE per week with EBP guidelines and/or articles regarding OUD treatment /care/resources	1 hour/month
